The Torrey Pines HS freshman football team won their home game against La Costa Canyon HS on Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup>. The final score was 20 – 14 Falcons. Logan Tomlinson received the kick-off to start the game. Falcons Christian Gange, Mason O’Rosky and Erik Fishman moved the ball down the field making several first downs. The Mavericks intercepted the ball and after several plays scored the first touchdown of the game and made the PAT. Jack Hoeprich received the kick-off at the Falcons’ 33 yard line. The Falcons moved down the field. Christian Gange picked up 14 yards on a carry with the help of Torran Raby, Mason O’Rosky and Jack Bailey, and Sandy Plashkes made a nice 46 yard pass to Christian Gange for a touchdown to tie the game. The PAT kicked by C.J. Stubbs was good. On the defensive side, Rowe Wheeler and Jeronimo Ramirez made nice tackles. Also playing on defense was Christian Gange, Jack Bailey, Logan Tomlinson, Brandon Hong, Mason O’Rosky, and Henry Hollen. The Score at the end of the first quarter was 7 – 7.

The Falcons scored two touchdowns in the second quarter.
