TPHS v Ramona HS Thursday, Oct. 27, 2011
Final Score: 35 - 13 Falcons!

Christian Gange, playing quarterback, pitched the ball to Jack Hoeplich for a gain of several yards and then Christian Gange made a 16 yard pass to Jack Bailey into the end zone for a touchdown. Harrison Cohen made a nice tackle on the biggest Bulldawg gain of the night to the Falcon 17 yard line. Jeronimo Ramirez made a quarterback sack. Falcons took possession of the ball at

their own 14 yard line. Playing on the offensive line was Jacob Saucedo, Brandon Hong, Joe Zapata, Reid Arno, and Erik Fishman. The scoreboard read 35 – 0 Falcons at the end of the third quarter.

In the fourth quarter, the Bulldawgs capitalized on a Falcon fumble and scored their first touchdown of the game. Jacob Saucedo was playing quarterback and covered several yards with a carry.
