TPHS v Rancho Buena Vista HS Wednesday, Oct. 5, 2011
Final Score: 28-18 Falcons!

The Torrey Pines HS Freshman squad won their home game on Wednesday, Oct. 5th beating the Rancho Buena Vista HS Longhorns 28-18. The Longhorns were the first to put points on the board with a touchdown. Their extra point attempt was no good. On the defensive side for the Falcons, Logan Tomlinson, Rowe Wheeler and Jeronimo Ramirez made nice tackles and Christian Gange made a fumble recovery. On the offensive side, Erik Fishman gained yards carrying the ball through the Longhorn defense several times. The scoreboard read 6-0 Longhorns at the end of the first quarter.

The Falcons started the second quarter with possession of the ball. Christian Gange and Erik Fishman carried the ball down the field making several first downs. Brandon Hong received a pass for a first and goal and then Christian Gange carried the ball into the Longhorn end zone for a touchdown. The PAT was good. Jack Bailey made a nice tackle to the Longhorn kick-off ball carrier, Jeronimo Ramirez made a tackle behind the line of scrimmage and Erik Fishman made a quarterback sack to get the ball back in the Falcons' possession. The Falcon defensive line kept the Longhorns from getting a first down, including a quarterback sack made by Jeronimo Ramirez. Again, Christian Gange and Erik Fishman carried the ball down the field for several first downs. Jack Bailey gained some yards for the Falcons receiving a nice pass from Sandy Plashkes and Mason O'Rosky made a nice carry. The scoreboard read 14-6 Falcons at the half.

The Falcons scored two touchdowns in the third quarter. To complete an impressive 75 yard drive, Alex Lukianov received a 20 yard pass for a touchdown. Brandon Hong also scored a touchdown with a pass from Christian Gange. Both PATs were good. Mason O'Rosky, Christian Gange and Logan Tomlinson made nice carries, Jack Bailey made a fumble recovery for a Falcons' first down, and Erik Fishman carried the ball through the Longhorn defense for several first downs.
