Former TPHS football coach Ed Burke is hosting a high school football team from Japan in August/September and is looking for families to help out by hosting a player or two in the home. You would be asked to provide lodging, meals, and transportation to and from school during their stay.

The team is comprised of 29 senior boys and 4 senior girl trainers. They will arrive on Friday, August 19, and depart early Monday, September 5 (Labor Day). The team will be attending school and practicing at Torrey Pines during their stay, so most of the transportation needs will be similar to that of your own family members attending the high school.

Most of the meals will be breakfast and dinner types, although there will be times when the team will be attending special events where the meal will be supplied. We will provide a daily stipend of \$15 per player to help offset your food and gas expenses.

This will be the fifth year that the senior members of the Ritsumeikan Uji Panthers football team selected Torrey Pines to be the host school for their "required" senior trip. It is a wonderful opportunity for us to get to know students from another culture, and an experience that will provide lifetime memories for you and your family.
